

## DRUMLINE

Drumline, as part of the Sooke Harmony Project, will start on Saturday, February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2016 at Journey Middle School.

To understand Drumline, go to YouTube and watch Drumline, the Last Battle, and that will give you a good idea of this exciting and fun program.

Drumming techniques will be learned as well as ensemble work with different types of drums. Marching in formations with the drums will also be part of the learning experience.

There will be TWO classes per week—Mondays (3:30—5:00 and 5:30—7:00) and Saturdays (10:30-12:00 and 12:30-2:00). To benefit fully, families need to make an initial commitment of 2 years.

The program is available FREE of charge and eligible to students who otherwise would not be able to participate in this musical learning experience. Other students will be accepted according to availability on a 50% scholarship. There will be an opening of up to one-third of the places for scholarship. For those students on half scholarship, the cost will be \$350 for term I, which ends in June.

Dr. Melissa Edwards, an excellent band director and experienced drumline instructor, will be the lead teacher for the course.
